# Nomination Form

#### Purpose

The Pellston High School Hall of Fame has been created to recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of Pellston Alumni and staff that through their work and service have brought pride and distinction to our school and community. These individuals exemplify the Mission of Pellston Public Schools which states:

"Our mission is to aid in the healthy development of each child's mind and body, emphasizing self-respect, positive attitudes, and high self-esteem in preparation for a successful life."

A permanent plaque will be displayed in a main hall or lobby to serve as inspiration to current and future students.

### Eligibility

Nominees for the Hall of Fame may include persons (living or deceased) who meet one or more of the qualifications in <u>each</u> of the following areas:

#### Tier I: The candidate

#### Tier II: The candidate:

1. Graduated with high honors at Pellston High School with a \_\_\_\_\_ GPA or was recognized as being in the top ten of the class.

2. Graduated with high honors having accomplished as least two of the following in the area of academics:

- 1. High academic achievement on Assessment Tests ie. MEAP, MME/ACT, SAT NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLAR
- 2. Student Leadership programs ie. National Honor Society, Student Council leadership position, Class president, Other leadership position (provide list)
- 3. Athletic achievements, list sport and number of years. Include School, League, Regional or State recognitions
- 4. Arts and Music awards ie. Phillip Sousa award, Herlocker Award (Crooked Tree Youth Arts)
- 5. Area Foundation Youth Advisory Committee

- 6. Other accomplishments: ie. Emmet 20/20 or other community related accomplishment
- 7. For teachers/administrators only—Earned Post Graduate degree (s), accomplishments as a teacher/administrator, classrooms innovations, teaching style, student achievement while a teacher etc.

#### Tier III. The candidate:

- 1. **If applicable:** Attended post secondary education, College, Vocational Education or other specialty education. State where candidate attended school, degrees earned, honors earned.
- 2. If applicable: Honors received while attending college, vocational school or other specialty education
- 3. If Applicable: Military service, military honors, wounded honors earned
- 4. Required Response: Service and dedication to Pellston High School (provide evidence)
- 5. **Required Response**: Career choice, number of years employed in a career, honors earned
- 6. **Required Response**: Service to community (School Board, Council Member, Planning Commission, Firefighter, Emergency Responder)
- 7. **Required Response:** Philosophy which guides the nominee to the dedication of their profession
- 8. If Applicable Other contributions to professional/civic organizations and/or publications, presentations and recognition
- 9. If Applicable describe in detail, how the staff member impacted students in or out of the classroom.

#### **Procedures for Nominations**

- 1) Nominations may be made by any staff member, student (past or present) or community member.
- 2) Applications must include all information requested above at the time of the application. <u>A photograph of the candidate must be included with each application.</u>
- Notification of open nominations will be made by announcement of the Board of Education and posted in the local paper.
- 4) Forms will be available at the Superintendent's Office.
- 5) Pellston High School Hall of Fame will be under the direction of the **Board of** Education.
- 6) The **Board of Education** will select appropriate dates for distribution and collection of nomination forms and publicity.

### Selection

A committee of the **Board of Education** will select the recipients of the Hall of Fame induction bi-annually. The committee will consist of volunteer members and those asked to serve.

The committee will include the following people:

- 1. Superintendent
- 2. High School Principal
- 3. Three Board members

The number of meetings will be determined based on the number of applications. A minimum of two meetings will be held the year of the induction.

The first meeting will be to screen the applications for those who do/do not qualify and then to select the top five candidates.

The second meeting will be held to make the final selection. This may include asking the nominating person to attend the meeting and give reasons for the selection of the nominee.

All applications will be saved for review for the following year.

Information on the application and all discussions during the selection process shall remain strictly confidential.

If the committee should find that no nominees meet the requirements for the Hall of Fame, no selection will be made that year.

### Presentation

Those selected will be notified of their Hall of Fame honor. If they choose to accept the award, they will be notified of the date the award will be presented.

Nominees selected for induction into the Pellston High School Hall of Fame will be honored at a specific time to be determined by the committee. This will be done on a biannual basis.

Each inductee will have an engraved plaque with their picture displayed at Pellston High School so that all students may be inspired by these special individuals and the many things they have achieved.
