<u>Substance Abuse Policy</u> – Discussions about substance abuse policy changes have continued since the December meeting. Tonight we are sharing the new proposed Substance Abuse Policy for Pellston Middle/High School with the Board of Education. Motion by Serenity Dankert and supported by Bryan Searles, to approve the substance abuse changes to our MS/HS Handbook. Motion carried 6-0.

MS/HS Bathroom Remodel Projects – Mr. Seelye led a discussion with the Board of Education about proposed improvements to our MS/HS bathrooms and shared a quote for materials from a local contractor. No action was requested at this time.

MS/HS Stage Floor Project – Mr. Seelye shared his research and some product samples with the Board of Education for the surface replacement of the MS/HS stage floor. Motion by Serenity Dankert and supported by Kristen Bauer-Frye, to approve the purchase of maple flooring from Boyne Hardwood in the amount of \$28,000.00. Motion carried 6-0.

<u>Bus Garage Doors</u> – Mr. Seelye shared the need for new doors at the bus garage with the Board of Education. Our new electric school buses are wider than our diesel buses and drivers currently have to pull in a mirror before driving into the bus garage. For just under \$20,000.00, North Shore Screen & Door can change the layout to two larger doors equipped with garage door openers. Motion by Rob Thomson and supported by Serenity Dankert, to approve the installation of two new garage doors in the amount of \$19,636.76 plus the cost of 'header' lumber material from North Shore Screen & Door, Motion carried 6-0.
